Decertification Vote

On Tuesday, November 7, the NLRB (National Labor Relations Board) was on site to conduct a union decertification election. The results were 73 to 37 in favor of decertification (not being represented by the SEIU union). As you know, many Sherwood Oaks employees, who were members of the bargaining unit, signed a petition to decertify and filed it in August with the NLRB. The employees have had their say. The SEIU has seven calendar days to file objections.

Shortly after the vote, management conducted a conference call with UPMC HR compensation department to formulate a timely compensation plan for staff.

Prior to the vote, Sherwood received notice of an informational picket for today from 2-5 PM by the SEIU. The location would be at the Rochester Road and Norman Drive intersection.
