#### **Reminder - Holiday Hours**

### **Medical Expense Tax Deduction**

Instead of eliminating the medical expense deduction as proposed in earlier versions of legislation, the new bill will expand the deduction for two years. All tax payers who itemize deductions will be able to write off qualifying medical expenses that exceed 7.5% of adjusted gross income for two years – 2017 and 2018. After that, the threshold will return to the 10% rate. As in the past, Sherwood Oaks' business office will distribute tax letters by the end of January.

#### **Falls**

Now that winter has officially arrived, we would like to remind you to walk on the sidewalks when you are out in the community; please do not take shortcuts across the grass from one sidewalk to another. There could be snow/ice on the ground and you could slip and fall. If you do happen to fall in your home, in the community or outside of Sherwood Oaks, please call the Community Nurse to report it, even if there is no injury.
