Please remember that parking a motorized scooter in the lobby, along the café, outside the main dining room or near the fireplace, card room and auditorium is not permitted. The designated area for scooter parking and battery charging is in the scooter room/gallery. If you are unable to walk from the scooter room/gallery to the main dining room or café, the dining room staff is available to valet park your scooter.
