# More Telephone Scams

I continue to hear about telephone scams from residents almost daily. Two recent scams that have been reported to me are:

- The "Grandchild is in jail" scam. The caller will pretend to be the "grandchild" and asks you to call a "court appointed attorney" who then asks for \$9,500 in cash in a plain brown envelope to obtain the release of the grandchild.
  - Please do not be fooled. Hang up and check with your family.
- Apple Computer They call you multiple times and claim your computer has been hacked. They promise diagnostic services for your computer and request gift cards for payment. Simply hang up. Apple will not contact you by phone.

If you receive these calls, here is my advice:

- Never provide your social security number, bank account numbers or other personal information over the phone unless you are extremely confident of the source to whom you are providing the information. Question gift cards for payment.
- Report the call to Mike Mills at ext. 8482.

# **Bulletin Board Guidelines**

I was asked to remind you of the guidelines for posting items on the resident bulletin boards in the mail room. Should you post, please note the following:

- Posted items should pertain to Sherwood Oaks or be of general interest to residents of Sherwood Oaks
- No item larger than 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> "x 11" is permitted
- Each item <u>must</u> be dated and have name of person posting it
- Items deemed inappropriate, or, do not have a date and name on it, will be removed

#### **Non-Sherwood Oaks Solicitation**

It is the policy of Sherwood Oaks to minimize solicitations directed to residents from residents, employees and others for non-Sherwood Oaks purposes. Direct resident-to-resident solicitation is strongly discouraged. Direct solicitation may be in the form of phone calls, letters in mail slots, e-mails or in-person solicitation. This includes solicitation for political votes. Please refrain from stuffing the mail room pigeon holes with voter guides and other candidate information.

Indirect solicitation, for a 501 (c.)(3)\* Charitable Organization, is permitted to be posted on the resident bulletin board in the mail room. These solicitations must follow the bulletin board rules and be limited to the authorized area of the bulletin board. Postings that are unsigned or deemed inappropriate will be removed by Administration.

Sherwood Oaks uses Road Runner for our recycling needs. I want to let you know that they do not accept plastic bags. We recommend you take them back to a supermarket or retail store for recycling. Colored glass containers are accepted, but the market for them has largely disappeared. Updated recycling signage will be posted in the trash rooms as to what is/is not recyclable.
