#### **Prescription Drugs**

I wanted to remind you of a few policies that Sherwood Oaks has in place regarding prescription drugs and drug take back day:

- ✓ Staff are not permitted to sign for and/or hold any prescriptions at the reception desk, community nurse office or medical office. Please schedule a time with the pharmacy delivering your prescriptions so that you are available to sign for and accept them.
- ✓ Staff are not permitted to hold on to any unwanted, unused or expired prescription or non-prescription drugs for residents for disposal at a Drug Take Back Day. You will need to hold on to these items yourself or take them to the drop-off drug collection box in the police department lobby at the Cranberry Township Municipal Building during normal business hours for proper disposal.

Sherwood Oaks will be participating in the DEA's National Drug Take Back Day on Friday, April 26 from 10 AM to 2 PM in the lobby. Mike Mills, Director of Security & Transportation, will oversee the collection of any unwanted, unused or expired drugs from residents and staff. This includes prescription and over-the-counter drugs. The medicine will be picked up by UPMC for proper disposal.

#### **Room Reservations for FY 2019**
