Farmer's Market

Our first farmer's market of 2019 will be held on Wednesday, June 12th from 11 AM-2 PM in the lobby. In addition to assorted produce, the following homemade items will also be available for purchase: banana-chocolate chip bread made with local honey, half pints of strawberry jam, strawberry rhubarb jam, and pints of rhubarb sauce (like applesauce).

Residents may use cash or charge items to their monthly statement. Guests and employees must use cash for purchases.

Clergy Parking Space

There is a parking space in the main parking lot (adjacent to the main entrance) designated for Clergy and Special Services only. Residents, guests and staff are not permitted to park in this space. If you are illegally parked here, you will be asked to move your vehicle to another space.
