Skilled Nursing Entrance Doors

The automatic doors at the entrance of the Skilled Nursing Unit are out of order. A temporary door has been installed until the replacement doors are received. The Wanderguard alarm system will continue to sound if a resident gets too close to the door. The yellow fire doors by the scooter room entrance will remain closed due to elopement precautions. You will need to manually open these doors to access the hallway by the Café, the elevator, the stairwell and the Skilled Nursing Unit.
