Pinewood Derby Event

The Mars Cub Scouts, Pack 413, will hold a Pinewood Derby on Saturday, March 21 in the Card Room and Auditorium. A Pinewood Derby is a racing event for unpowered, unmanned miniature cars. Scouts, with the help of adults, build their own cars from wood kits (kits include block of pine wood, plastic wheels and metal axles). The cars are then designed, cut, modified and painted by the racers (within certain rule constraints) for race day. Each car races four times on a digitally timed track to determine winners in their category.

Residents are invited to race in the derby; registration is required. The sign-up sheet is posted on the administrative bulletin board in the mail room. The deadline to sign up is Friday, February 7.
