To ensure readiness here at Sherwood Oaks, our leaders participate in UPMC Senior Communities daily briefings. Currently, Sherwood Oaks is discouraging visitors and I anticipate visitor limitation and additional screening to soon follow.

We continue to stress the importance of frequent handwashing, coughing and sneezing etiquette and staying home if not feeling well. There are a number of hand sanitizer stations throughout the building and one was added near the new puzzle table.

Infection control procedures are in place across <u>all</u> departments to keep residents and employees safe.

- The main doors to the Oak Grove Center and the doors to the Skilled Nursing ambulance entrance are now locked 24 hours a day. Please ring the bell or use the phone at each entrance to call the nurse's station for access to these units.

Although we will still provide off-site transportation, I ask you to consider, for the time being, whether your off-campus trip is necessary.

We will continue to monitor and, as month end approaches, update you regarding April events.
