Updates

Governor Wolf has extended the stay at home order to June 4 for all counties in the red phase including Butler County. Butler County will move to the yellow phase next Friday, May 15. This does not, however, equate to changing current campus restrictions and service delivery. The risk of serious illness is still a very real danger to residents on our campus due to age and health status. Services such as Fitness Center and Beauty Shop would be last phase/green and have not been given permission to reopen. I am pleased to say that Sherwood Oaks has not furloughed employees and participates in the UPMC pay protection plan.
