## **Scam Calls**

Here are the most popular scams reported by residents over the past week:

- A call stating that your Social Security number has been used in other states. The caller cannot provide you the number being used due to privacy laws, but you can tell them your SS# and he/she will confirm it.
  - Never provide your social security number, bank account numbers or other personal information over the phone unless you are extremely confident of the source to whom you are providing the information.
- A voicemail stating that \$199 is going to be charged to the checking account or plastic card attached in our system within 24 hours for the auto renewal of your subscription. If you want to cancel the subscription, please press one or call us immediately at support 1-916-850-3139.
  - Do not press one or call the number back.
