Transportation Home from Local Hospitals

Sherwood Oaks' security department offers return trips from local hospitals weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., depending on staffing availability and medical needs. During off hours, when a resident is discharged from UPMC Cranberry or UPMC McCandless emergency room, and need a return trip to Independent Living, a "Cab Slip" can be requested from the discharge nurse. Cab Slips are available free of charge. The hospitals use a third-party provider called "Z-Trip" for this service. Health Center residents typically need to be returned via ambulance or wheelchair van. In this case, the discharge planner would coordinate transportation because a security vehicle and/or the "Z-trip" may not be an option.
