Housekeeping Credits

Please be advised that effective July 1, 2026, there will be updates to the housekeeping credits. Residents will receive housekeeping credits only if:

- ✓ Housekeeping services are canceled by Sherwood Oaks.
- ✓ For residency contracts dated prior to March 2025, residents must be away for 7 or more consecutive days in order to qualify for a housekeeping credit.
- ✓ For residency contracts dated March 2025 and newer, residents must be away for 30 or more consecutive days in order to qualify for a housekeeping credit.

Housekeeping credits will no longer be issued when a resident chooses to cancel their scheduled cleaning service. We encourage all residents to take advantage of this complimentary weekly housekeeping service as part of the amenities offered at Sherwood Oaks.
