Telephone System Update

Technicians are currently working to program the new hardware for the telephone system. Implementation has not gone as smooth as expected, resulting in intermittent phone outages throughout the campus. In addition, voicemail is currently unavailable. If you have a non-urgent message for a specific director or the maintenance department, we suggest using email or stopping at the reception desk and the staff will relay the message to them. Administrative telephone/email lists are available at the reception desk. If you experience an emergency, push your arial alert pendant or wall transmitter and security will respond promptly, or, call 911 from a cell phone.

The reception desk phone has been forwarded to the gatehouse through Monday morning. The cell phone number to reach the reception desk through Monday morning is 724-766-9739. After hours, this phone number will be answered by the security officers at the Gatehouse.
